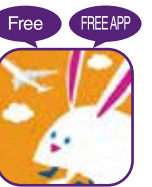

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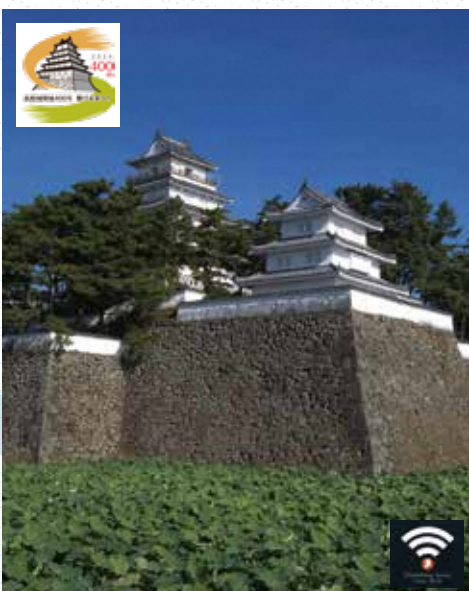

Shimabara Castle



Shimabara Castle

Matsukura Bungonokami Shigemasa took seven years from 1618 to construct Shimabara Castle. It is a magnificent castle in Azuchi-Momoyama style incorporating a five-story castle keep as a core and large and small turrets in key places.

Old Samurai House



Old Samurai House

The residences of samurai (Japanese warriors), with an annual stipend of no more than 70 koku (1 koku = 180) of rice, were constructed adjacent to the western outskirts of Shimabara Castle at the time it was built. This town is called "Teppo-machi" (lit. a gun town) because it was populated mainly by infantry unit members armed with guns who lived in the town during the war. Abundant spring water was diverted to the waterway in the center of the street, and it was maintained carefully for domestic use.

Shinozuka House

The Shinozuka family's head was named Junemon down through the generations. The family was originally from Mikawa's Fukuoka in Aichi Prefecture. The family line continued until early in the Meiji period (1868-1912) with an annual stipend of 8 to 13 koku (1 koku = 180) of rice for two people, and mainly worked as court secretaries or magistrates.



Yamamoto House

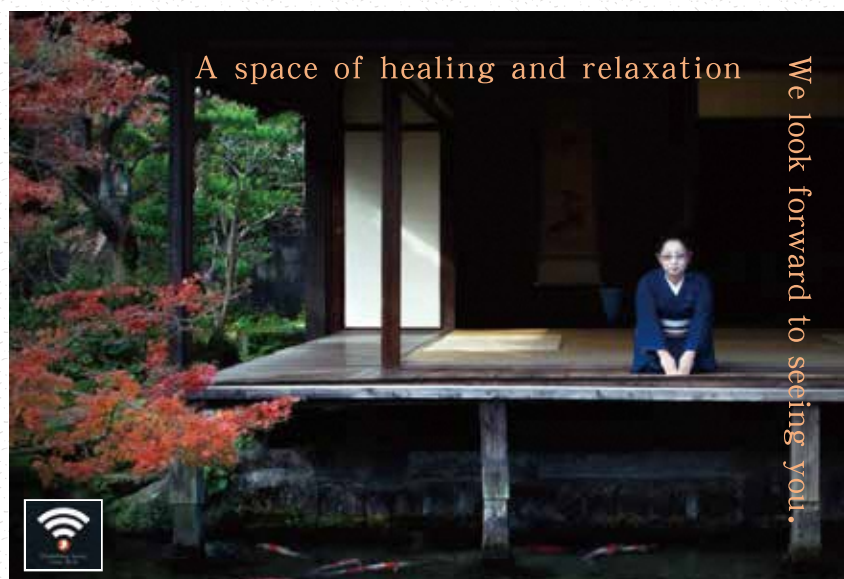
The Yamamoto family's Segozaemon the first became a vassal to Lord Matsudaira Tadafusa's father Tadatoshi (the Lord of Yoshida Castle in Mikawa, Aichi Prefecture). He served to the Matsudaira family from 1749 to 1774 and followed Tadafusa (the sixth lord of the castle) when Tadafusa took over the jurisdiction of Shimabara. Altogether, he served a total of 13 lords until the end of the Edo period (1868).



Torita House

The Torita family was an old family that descended from the lineage of Lord Matsudaira. The family moved to Shimabara in 1669. The whole area was occupied by middle- and lower-class samurai (Japanese warrior/class) residences. Each residence was on a premises of approximately 300 square meters, and its yard was planted with fruit trees, such as loquat, persimmon, and citrus.

Yusui-teien Shimeiso

There are three large and small ponds on the premises, where 3,000 tons of water are released every day. Shimeiso is a nostalgic place where the quiet appearance, forgotten the time, and a relaxing space.

Shimabara Yusuikan

Shimabara Yusuikan is a free resting place in the Town of Swimming Carp, a typical spring water destination in Shimabara. It is a space of healing where people can relax while listening to the babbling of spring water.

Seiryutei as a local sightseeing hub exhibits Shimabara's special quality products and provides tourist information. The colorful Nishikigoi (carps) swim relaxedly in the pond which used abundant spring water. It is a highlight.

Hamanokawa Spring Tourism Exchange Center Ginsui

Ginsui, the originator of kanzarashi (small dumplings made from rice flour, cooled in Shimabara's spring water, and then covered in syrup and eaten), has been revived adjacent to the Hamanokawa Spring in August 2016. It has been a place loved by the locals for a long time and visited by many famous people over the years.

Yutorogi-no-yu

Yutorogi-no-yu is a spa where visitors can enjoy different types of hot spring baths (large public baths, medicated baths, water baths, and saunas, as well as walking bath facilities for people with bathing suits).

Drinking Fountain and Hot Spring Water

There are seven drinking fountains serving spring water throughout the city, where people can drink the hot spring water freely. It is believed by many to help with conditions such as diabetes, gout, gastric duodenal ulcer, and reflux esophagitis.

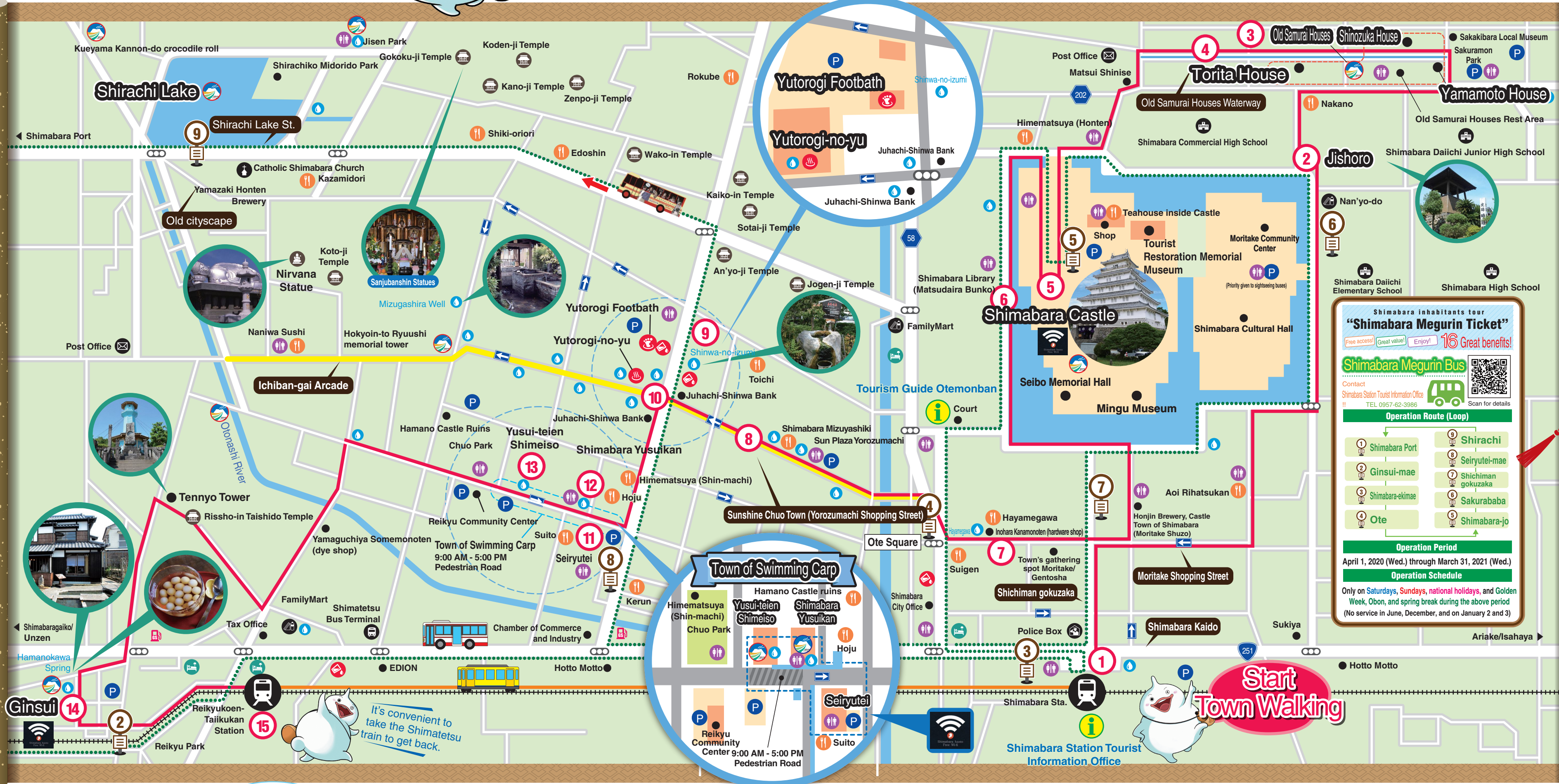
